

# **ABERDEEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL FACTS BYLAWS**

## **ARTICLE I: Aberdeen Elementary FACTS**

**Required** The name of the organization shall be the Aberdeen Elementary School FACTS

## **ARTICLE II: PURPOSE**

1. A group of parents, guardians, and community members all dedicated to the success of AES students, faculty, and staff.
2. Conduct fundraising to enhance the educational opportunities of students, and to conduct faculty and staff appreciation and recognition.
3. Representatives serve on school level committees including the school improvement team and house committee.
4. Facilitates volunteer opportunities that support a variety of school activities.

## **ARTICLE III: POLICES**

1. The organization shall operate under the umbrella of FACTS and adhere to the rules and guidelines for tax-exempt 501(c)3 organizations.
2. This organization shall follow the policies and standards of the Moore County School District.
3. The District reserves the right to countermand any decision affecting the District or property.
4. In case of dissolution of the organization, the assets of the organization shall be deposited to the Aberdeen Elementary School Student Services fund.

## **ARTICLE IV: MEMBERSHIP**

1. We shall strive to have officers as follows:
  - a. President or Chairperson (elected)
  - b. Vice President or Vice-Chairperson
  - c. Secretary (elected)
  - d. Treasurer (elected)

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2. Nomination of officers shall be taken during the August general FACTS meeting.
3. Election shall be by ballot.
4. Officers shall begin their term(s) following the last FACTS meeting of the year.
5. Outgoing officers shall transfer books, bank accounts, to the newly elected board upon reconciliation of June bank statement, or upon the discretion of the board.
6. The Executive Board shall fill vacancies by appointment.
7. Bylaws will be updated as needed by officers and school administration.
